In reference to: *the recognition of studies of the Romanian citizens, citizens from states of the European Union and of the Swiss Confederation, refugees and family members of Romanian citizens for access to studies in the academic year 2023/2024*

Dear Rector,

We are hereby sending you information regarding the recognition of the studies of Romanian candidates from member states of the EU, EEA and the Swiss Confederation, refugees and family members in view of their access to studies in the academic year 2023/2024:

- recognition files are sent online, through the **Electronic Single Contact Point (PCUe)**ⁱ by accessing <https://edirect.e-guvemare.ro> the operational procedure "*Recognition of diplomas obtained by Romanian or European citizens abroad or to an International School in Romania in order to continue their studies in Romania*"; when uploading the documents to the platform, the name of each candidate will also be mentioned in the "Message" entry;
- The certificate of recognition of the studies and the Certificate regarding the studies carried out abroad (signed electronically) will be sent, through PCUe, to the requesting universities; the existing QR code on the document issued by CNRED (*National Centre for Equivalence and Recognition of Diplomas*) can be used to connect to the module "Verification of file status" to be found on the CNRED website <https://cnred.edu.rolro/dosare>, - to check that the document is issued by CNRED;
- Certificates/certifications of recognition issued by CNRED in previous years are valid for registration for studies in the academic year 2023/2024;
- higher education institutions have the obligation to request to CNRED, by the date of the examination of the completion of the studies, to issue the Certificate of Acknowledgment / the Certification regarding the studies completed abroad based on the final diploma of studies, in view of the replacement of the provisional Certificates issued for enrolling to the study programmes.
- Taking into account the administrative measures adopted at the national level regarding the consolidation of the transparency of information and in order to facilitate the applicants' access to the study programmes offered by your institution, we hereby appreciate your institution's continued desire to post on its website, also in an international language, all the necessary information regarding the study programmes available for all the three university cycles, as well as to what the process of organization, selection and admission is concerned.

Please send us within 10 days of the receipt of the present document, the contact details (e-mail, telephone) of the persons appointed to manage the aspects related to the recognition of the diplomas (management or operating position at the university level).
